NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the provisions of the aforesaid section,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the eight supervisory districts of St. Lawrence county provided for in subdivision 5-h of section 381 of the Education Law, be and they are hereby reduced to seven; and that the towns of said county be organized into supervisory districts and numbered as follows:
